

Strath Haven Condominium Association VAN SNOW GUIDELINES

In order to best service the community and to permit residents to make the proper arrangements for using the van shuttle, the Association has adopted this policy for inclement weather situations. Please refer to the Association's website for emergency condition postings.

For snow accumulations from a dusting to 3", the van should operate on its usual schedule. However, it is possible the driver could find the roads hard to navigate due to slippery conditions and would, therefore, have to make adjustments to the pick-up and drop-off locations at our building or train station. We will do our best to inform you of any changes.

For snow accumulations from 3 to 5", that occur during the overnight hours and stop by 5 a.m., there will be a 2-hour delay. This should give the crews (ours and the Borough's) and our employees the needed time to clear the parking lots, streets and vehicle of snow. *If it occurs on a Monday, Wednesday or Friday, then the shopping trips would be moved to 12:30 p.m.*

For snow accumulations 5 to 8", that occur during the overnight hours and continue into the daytime hours, it is possible that the van **WILL NOT** operate as we believe it could be too hazardous to have it out on the roadways.

For snow accumulation greater than 8", that occur overnight, the van **would not be in service that day.** If conditions should improve enough during the day, we will consider putting the van into service for the afternoon train runs.

For black ice and icy conditions, a case-by-case decision will be made. We will do our best to keep you informed of our decision.

This policy is subject to change, and we value your input as we strive to maintain everyone's safety.
